The Problem

- ◆ Retail, fuel and cargo theft have exploded in California.
- ◆ Drug addiction and homelessness have become a humanitarian crisis.
- ◆ The consequences are impacting public safety and the quality of life of all Californians.
- ◆ The problem cannot be fixed without passing a ballot initiative.

The Solution

The Homelessness, Drug Addiction and Theft Reduction Act will:

- ◆ Hold repeat thieves accountable with felony prosecution.
- ◆ Allow treatment-mandated felony prosecution for 3rd time hard drug convictions.
- ◆ Tackle the fentanyl crisis by going after fentanyl drug dealers.

The Path to Success

- ◆ High voter support shown in multiple polls.



70% support based on ballot label alone.



89% support changes to Proposition 47 to hold repeat offenders accountable.



94% support stronger penalties for fentanyl.

- ◆ Cost to qualify initiative: \$7-8 million
